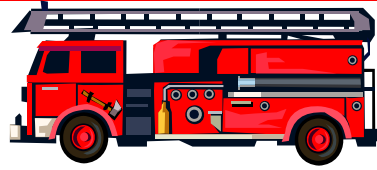

**Bond Issue for New Ambulance & Fire Station on April 8th Ballot
No Tax Increase on Ballot**

Message from District Officers

Dear Residents:

On Tuesday, April 8th, you the voters of the Northeast Ambulance & Fire Protection District (formerly known as the Normandy Fire Protection District) will have the opportunity to vote on Proposition B, a \$10,700,000 bond issue for the building of a new firehouse and

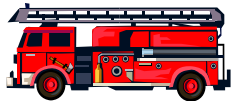
ambulance station as well as administrative offices. In addition, the bond issue will finance the purchase of new ambulances and fire trucks as well as the purchase of equipment to aid in the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services and the fighting of fires. There will be no tax increase on the ballot. The bonds will be retired from our current operating revenues. In order to purchase land, construct a new ambulance and fire station and to purchase the necessary medical and firefighting equipment, we must borrow funds as we do not have sufficient reserves to pay for those items. Under Missouri law, the district may not borrow funds except upon approval of a 4/7th majority of the voters. In fact, under Missouri law we may not use public funds to support or oppose the bond issue. The only thing that we may do is inform you of the issue and let you the voters decide to vote for or against the bond issue. Thus, we have determined to simply provide you with information about the bond issue for your edification and decision. We will attempt to provide you as much information as possible in order for you to make an informed decision about the proposed bond issue. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the district office, for information only, at 314-382-1501. The Fire Chief and his staff stand ready to provide to you any information that you may need about the bond issue.

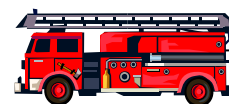

Shall the Northeast Ambulance and Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, incur an indebtedness of said District in the amount of Ten Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$10,700,000) and issue general obligation bonds of said District in evidence thereof in order to or for the purchase and clearing of land or real estate, the construction, equipment, and maintenance of administration buildings, fire and ambulance stations, garages and houses, and the purchase of ambulances, fire trucks, emergency medical service equipment, paramedical equipment, fire protection equipment and fire-fighting apparatus and auxiliary equipment for said District?
