

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE PROPOSED RATES OF TAXES FOR THE NORTHEAST AMBULANCE AND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO BE FILED WITH THE COUNTY OF ST. LOUIS NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1, 2009**
